- 7. This will be a live webinar by Zoom webinar technology and there will be no permission to record it. Only registered individuals would be permitted to attend.
- 8. The attendee would need to have a Webcam and microphone attached to their device. Each attendee would be monitored throughout the session to ensure the attendance and presence during the lecture for conference with CME rules. This would mimic a live training as nearly as possible.
- 9. Our IT team would provide easy to follow instruction and would also be available during the workshop to sort out any problems and trouble shoot any issues.
